Simple : Cloud Platform

Applicable to: Contractors with smaller IT departments **Approach**: Leverage a cloud storage platform with collaboration features.

Digitization Approaches

Advanced: Adopt a Construction Mngt Platform

Applicable to: Contractors with a greater IT / system configuration team **Approach:** Adopt a specific construction management platform

Custom: Own Platform

Applicable to: Contractors with a large IT organization **Approach:** Develop own system / avoid vendor lock in

Applicable to: Contractors with smaller IT departmentsApproach: Leverage a cloud platform with file collaboration features.Cloud Platforms to consider

Impacts: Single source of truth, Processes still largely manual, ERP still does a lot of the heavy liftingKey to success: Support for construction specific file viewers, large file support, file request and transmit capability, vendor should have Al strategy



Advanced



Applicable to: Contractors with a greater IT / system configuration team Approach: Adopt a specific construction management platform Cloud Platforms to consider

- Procore
- Autodesk Construction Management
- Aconex
- InEight
- CMiC

Impacts: Can be costly – typically charge a % of construction value, Requires configuration, training and change management to implement, Requires continuous maintenance, Significant process automation opportunity, consider longer term record storage
Key to success: Look for strong ecosystem of partners and integrations, field support, AI strategy of the platform.



Custom



Applicable to: Contractors with a larger IT organization

Approach: Develop own systems or blend systems in order to avoid vendor lock in.

Impacts: Avoid vendor lock-in, avoid construction value fee basis, long term records management, more suited for contractors that are vertically integrated.

Key to success: Custom configured to your processes, ensure can integrate with LLM for knowledge, typically built on a platform

Initiatives & Observations


- Small internal IT support therefore focus is on leveraging technology partners.
- Current Digitization strategy
 - Currently adopting Procore as Construction Management platform to automate construction management processes.
 - Approach has been to introduce one tool at a time (as practical), ensure it works, find a business champion for that tool/ subject area before moving on to the next tool.
 - Selected due to breadth of ecosystem, financial and project management capabilities.
 - Deployed Dropbox Sign across all business processes, leveraging integration with Procore
 - Supports more tools, more intuitive, TEAM IM is a very responsive partner.
 - Autodesk AEC tools, have been using these for a long time, keeping abreast with Autodesk updates
 - DroneDeploy. Aerial 360 Imagery used for site inspections, mapping and marketing.
- Future Projects
 - Adopting Dropbox for long term record (drawing and specifications per project) storage and large file storage.(site photo's and video's, drone footage).
 - Working out how to leverage Gen Al.
